The number of new applications for incorporation of personal companies amounted to (494), rejected (2117) applications, and approved applications (998), and the total number of approved applications canceled after review amounted to (166) applications, companies established (1667), companies under establishment (998) applications, and approved applications (2246).

The total applications for licenses of entity companies under issuance amounted to (929) applications, the total licenses issued were (3270) licenses, and the total licenses submitted were (2878) licenses.



By reviewing the data on commercial licenses (natural person) for the month of September 2025, we found the following: -

(77) licenses with commercial activity were issued, a decrease of 3% compared to the previous month, (36) new licenses with craft activity were issued, an increase of 24%, (105) transactions for the commercial registration certificate were issued, an increase of 18%, and (434) transactions for license renewal for a natural person, and (156) addresses were changed with a decrease of 8%, while the transaction of changing or amending a trade name amounted to (43) transactions, with a decrease of 4%, and (22) transactions for modifying activities were amended. Activity of a natural person with a decrease of 24% compared to the previous month, and the cancellation of (207) licenses with a decrease of 14%, and (8) transactions for the transfer of heirs to the natural person with a decrease of 33%, and (1) a transaction of changing the agent of the heirs in September 2025, and the number of transactions for the waiver of licenses with commercial activity reached (33) transactions with an increase of 6%, and (18) licenses with professional activity were waived with an increase of 38% For the current month, (1) brokerage book issuance transactions decreased by 67%, and (10) brokerage books for natural persons were renewed in September 2025.

september 2025 compared to august 2025**





The number of license issuance transactions reached (6) transactions, an increase of 100% compared to the previous month, as for the license renewal transaction, a number of (53) licenses were renewed for the legal person, an increase of 47%, and the number of transactions for changing the address reached (9) transactions, an increase of 80%, and for the modification of activities (change, addition, cancellation), (2) activities were amended, (30) licenses for the legal person were canceled, with an increase of 650%, and (26) licenses were issued to replace the lost legal person in September 2025, a decrease of 7% compared to the month. 

By looking at the data of the companies of persons (main companies) for the month of September 2025, we find the following:

A number of (1416) permanent/temporary licenses were issued for main persons companies, an increase of 5% compared to the previous month, while the license renewal transactions were (1228) transactions, an increase of 5%, and the address of (1066) main companies was changed, a decrease of 6%, and the number of transactions for changing the trade name reached (196) transactions, a decrease of 9%. As for the transactions of amending the management item, (907) transactions were made, a decrease of 2%, while the modification or addition of a commercial address was (91) transactions, an increase of 10% compared to the previous month, and the number of transactions for adding a license activity amounted to (177) transactions, a decrease of 22%, while the deletion of an activity from a

license amounted to (118) transactions, a decrease of 6% compared to the previous month, and the number of (612) transactions in adding an activity to the company's contract with a decrease of 7%, and (142) transactions deleting an activity from the company's contract with an increase of 7%, while the change in the activity of the company's contract was (53) transactions with a decrease of 23%, and as for the number of transactions for changing the activity of the commercial license, it reached (73) transactions, a decrease of 18% compared to the previous month, while in the transactions of capital increase, (66) transactions were made in the current month with an increase of 25%, and the number of (6) transactions in the reduction of the capital by an increase of 100%, and the number of (348) was amended. The number of transactions for the entry of a partner reached (724) transactions, the number of transactions in the exit of a partner with a decrease of 2%, and the number of (310) transactions in the dissolution and liquidation of the company reached (24%), and the number of transactions for changing the legal entity of the company reached (50) transactions with an increase of 11%, and the number of applications for a true license to manage companies reached (267) applications, an increase of 1% compared to the previous month, while in the transactions of a request to print an extract or a statement, (13518) transactions with an increase of 10%, and the re-issuance of a license according to the decision of the Status Amendment Committee amounted to (10) transactions, a decrease of 58% compared to the previous month.





statement of transactions of the advertising and promotional licensing administration during september 2025 compared to august







By looking at the data of the Precious Metals Department for the month of September 2025, we found the following:-

The total fees collected for the inspection amounted to an estimated amount of (199,642,820) thousand Kuwaiti dinars, an increase of 69% compared to August 2025, where the Precious Metals Department examined (1,392) grams of artificial stones of value, and (5,486) grams of other precious stones, and the accessory of the diamond restaurant weighed (160) grams, and (112,642) grams of stone inlaid accessory in the current month, and the weight of diamonds inlaid by the management was (120) grams, and (271) grams of platinum, while the platinum inlaid with diamonds weighed (208) grams, and the weight of diamond-inlaid titanium was (45) grams, and the amount of gold examined weighed (2,512,271) grams, and (230,369) grams of gold inlaid with precious stones, (133,925) grams of gold inlaid with diamonds, and the weight of stainless steel ceramic watches was (3,012), and for 0.05 watches, it reached (101,467) grams, and watches amounted to 0.1 (67,315) grams, and (2,550,370) grams of silver were examined. 3,032 grams of silver inlaid with diamonds, and 151,450 grams of silver inlaid with precious stones in September 2025.


**the index of the weighted value of most important




By reviewing the data of the Real Estate Services and Valuation Department for the month of September 2025, we found the following: -

The Real Estate Services and Valuation Department issued (85) transactions in September 2025 compared to (89) transactions for the month of August 2025, a decrease of 4%, under 8 types of transactions, where the number of transactions for the issuance of real estate brokerage books was (17) transactions, an increase of 21% compared to the previous month. The number of transactions for the addition of the Real Estate Brokerage Deputy in September amounted to (2) transactions with a decrease of 33%, the request to renew the Deputy (1) transaction with a decrease of 67%, the request to renew the identity of a real estate broker with (13) transactions with an increase of 117%, the request to issue the identity of a real estate broker – a deputy with a decrease of (1) transactions with a decrease of 50%, and the number of requests to cancel the brokerage book reached (4) transactions with a decrease of 75%, while in the transactions of the request for renewal of the brokerage book, the number of transactions was (33) transactions. An increase of 18%, and the issuance of a real estate broker ID was requested with (14) transactions, a decrease of 7% compared to the previous month.







The total Kuwaiti certificates of oil and non-oil origin amounted to about KD 263 million, distributed among the GCC countries, Arab Islamic countries, countries of the European continent, countries of the African continent, countries of the American continent (North and South), countries of the Asian continent and Australia, where the value of certificates for the GCC countries was about KD 149 million, achieving an increase of KD 128% compared to the previous month, and the percentage of certificates from Arab Islamic countries increased by 189% compared to the previous month, achieving certificates estimated at about KD 68 million, and the value of certificates from European countries reached about KD 46 million, a decrease of 33% compared to the previous month, and the value of certificates for the countries of the African continent amounted to about KD 207 million, with a decrease of 99%, and the value of certificates for the countries of the two continents of the Americas amounted to about KD 250 thousand and constituted an increase of 54% compared to the previous month, while for Asian countries and Australia, the value of their certificates amounted to about KD 17 thousand per cent, a decrease of 14%, and it is noted that there has been an increase in the value of the total certificates for the month of September 2025 for the previous month's certificates , which amounted to 53%.




monthly statement of disbursed support amounts for the month


relative distribution of transactions conducted using ration card during september 2025
