# Commercial Licenses

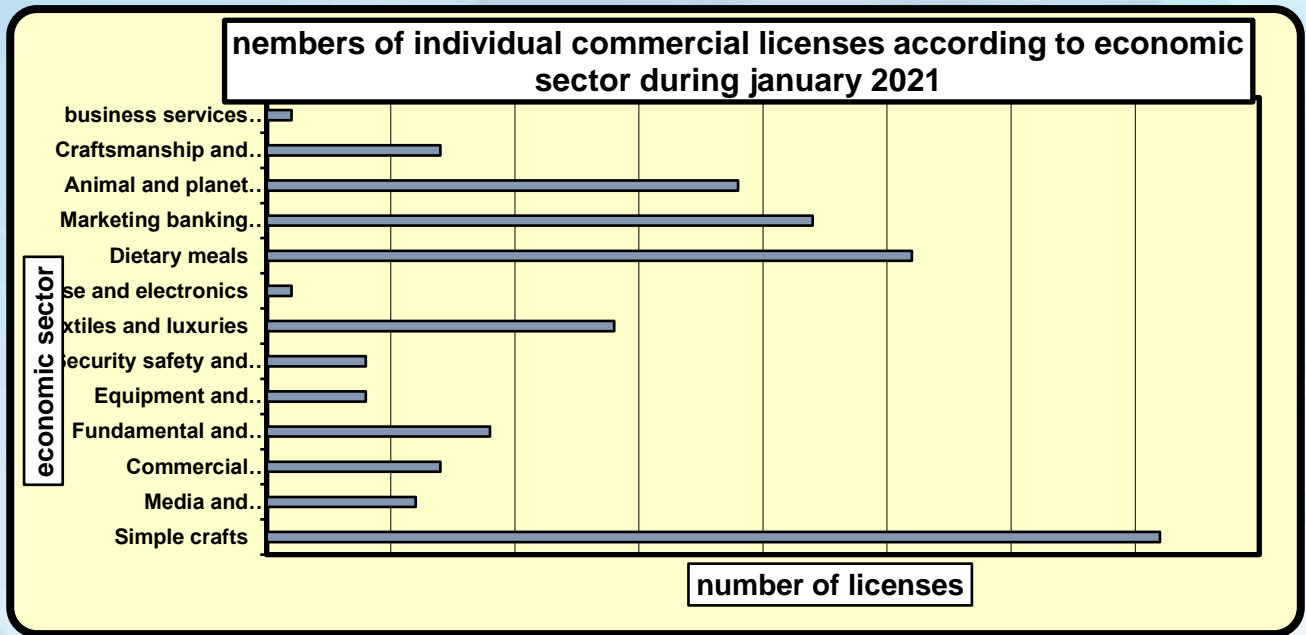
## Individual commercial licenses sector

### 1. Volume of Licenses Issued by Economic Sector:

The number of individual commercial licenses that the Ministry agreed to issue during January 2021 reached (156) licenses in various economic activities, including (36) licenses in the simple crafts sector, (26) licenses in food sector, (22) marketing, banking and hotels, (19) licenses in Animals and plant products (14) licenses in Textiles and Luxuries, (9) licenses in the Base and electronics.

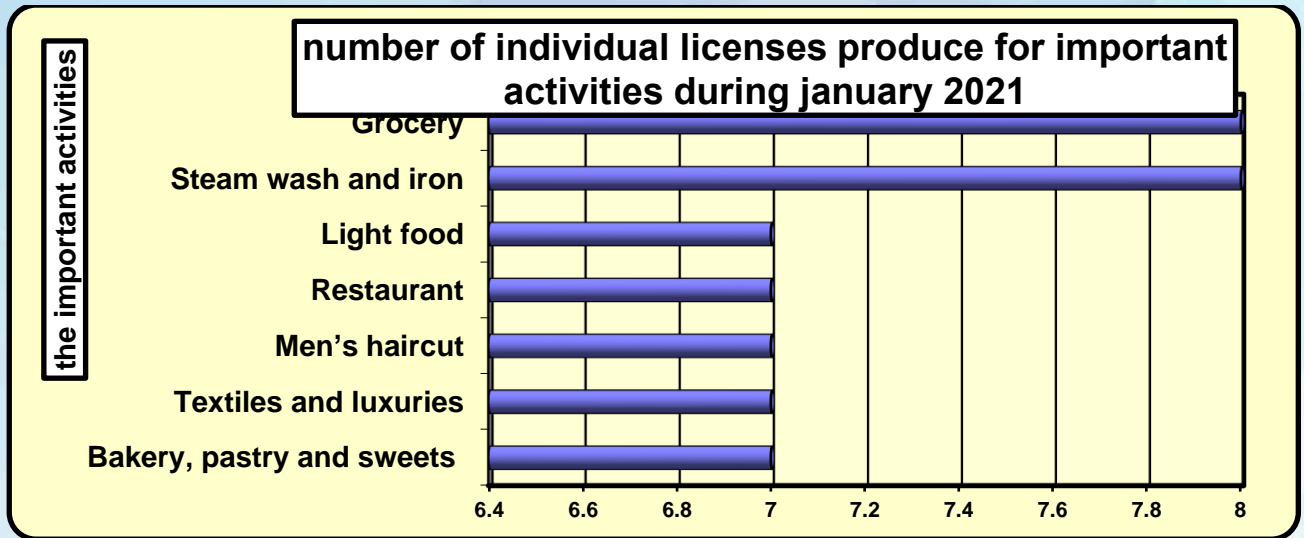
## 2. Volume of licenses with respect to activities:

licenses were classified during one month into several economic activities (156) reaching (7) classifications. Some other activities were not classified due to their small size and large number.

Most notably activity was (Grocery, Steam wash and iron) at a rate estimated about 5% of the total licenses, followed by the activity of (Light Food, Restaurant, men's haircut, Luxuries, Sweet and pastries) at a rate of 4% of the total licenses, followed by the activity of (men's barber shop) at a rate of 4% of the total licenses, and the rest of the licenses for other activities are excused from classification were at rate of 67% from total licenses.

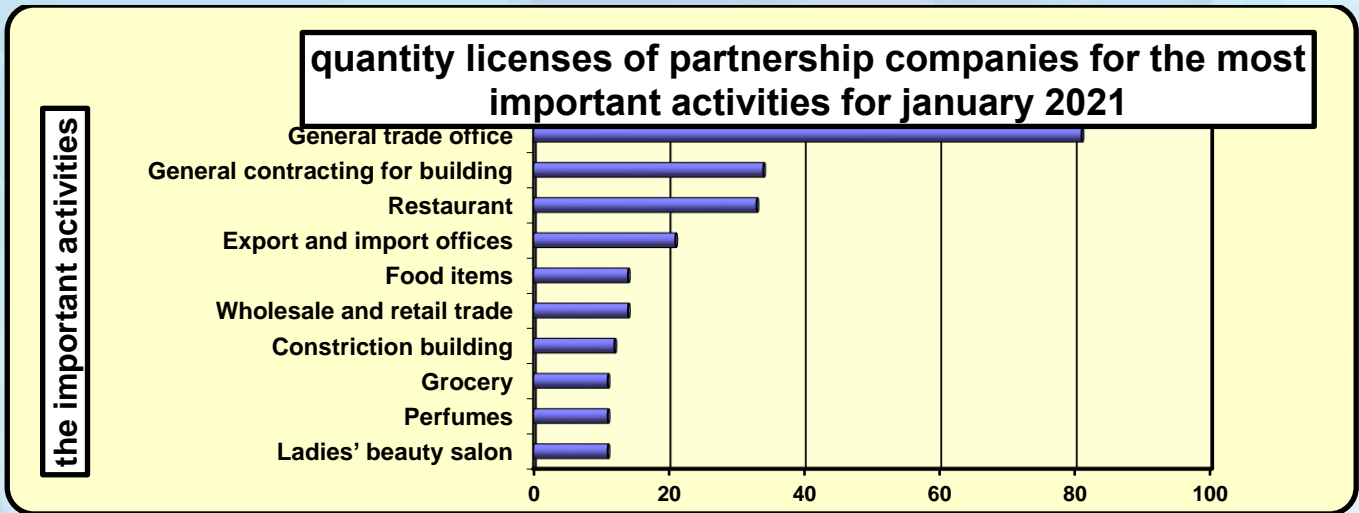
### 3: Volume of licenses for companies of persons issued by activities .

(634) licenses were classified during the month into many economic activities (10) activities, with some other activities that could not be classified due to their small size and large number.

Most notably, (general trade office) activity was about 13% of the total licenses, followed by (General contracting for building, Restaurant) at a rate of about 5% of the licenses, followed by the following activities (import and export office) at a rate of about 3% for each activity from the above, followed by the following activities ( Food items, Wholesale and retail trade, Building construction, Grocery, perfume, Ladies' beauty salon ) at a rate of about 2% for each activity from the above, the rest of the licenses for other activities were not classified and they present 62% of the total licenses.

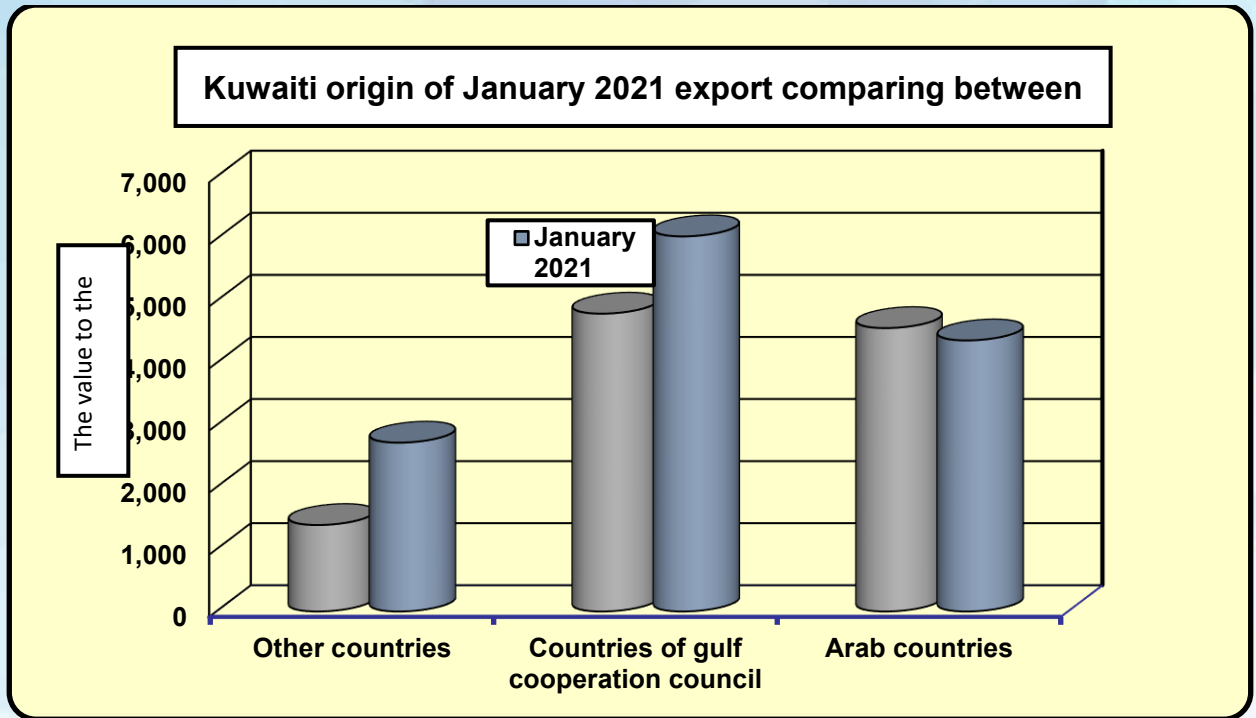


## Kuwaiti exports

Total exports of Kuwait origin during January 2021 amounted about 13 million KD, and they were distributed on Gulf countries, Arab countries, and the rest of World. Arabic countries achieved the value of 4 million KD achieving percentage estimated about 33%. The percentage of the rest of the world reached about 21% achieving exports value estimated at about 3 million KD. The value of exports to the Gulf Cooperation Council countries were estimated about 6 million KD and it present 46% of the total exports. It is noted that there has been an increase in the value of total exports relative to last month's exports, which amounted to 18%. Comparing with the same month of last year, there has been an increase in the export percentage estimated about 22%.

### First: Exports of Kuwait origin to Al Arabiya Group:

Iraq occupied the forefront of these countries, with exports estimated about 2 million Kuwaiti KD, at an estimated rate of about 47% of the total exports to Arab countries, followed by exports to Jordan, achieving about 29%, as the total exports were estimated about million KD, followed by the third place Egypt, where it achieved a rate of about 9%, and the value of the exports amounted to about 381 thousand dinars. The fourth place was for Algeria, where the value of the exports amounted to about 190 thousand dinars, with an estimated rate of about 4%, and as for the rest of the exports for this month, they were distributed all over Lebanon, Yemen, Morocco, Somalia, Tunisia.

It is noticeable that the exports of this month decrease to Arab countries in relation to last month's exports, which are estimated at about 6%. There has also been a slight decrease in the month's exports to Arab countries compared to the exports of the same month of last year, at a rate estimated about 4%.

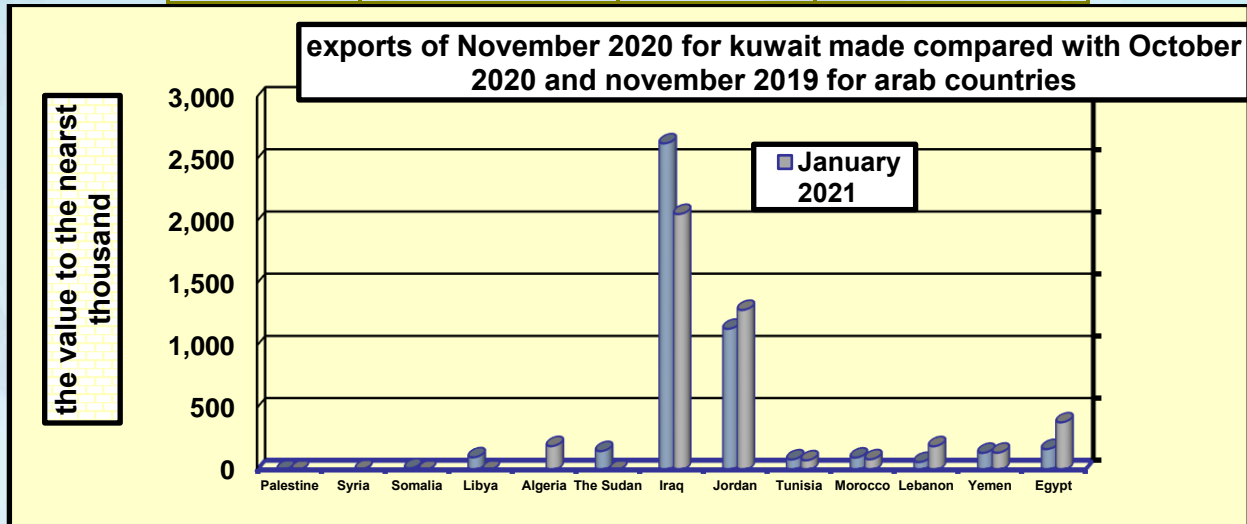

### Second: Kuwaiti origin exports to other countries of the world:

As for exports to other countries of the world, Belgium occupied the forefront of the world's exporting countries, achieving the value of exports amounted to about 1 million Kuwaiti dinars, with an estimation of 41% of the total exports to other world countries. Turkey ranked second with exports estimated about 500 Thousand Kuwaiti Dinars, with an estimated rate of about 36% of total exports, and the third place was for Italy, achieving the total exports amounted to about 424 thousand Kuwaiti Dinars with an estimation of about 30% of the total exports to the world countries. As for the rest of the exports of other world countries during this month, they were distributed among all Spain, India, , Greece, Slovenia, France, Cyprus ,Guiana ,Brazil ,Peru ,Portugal, Sweden ,Colombia ,Germany.

It is noticeable that the exports of the rest of the other countries of the world increased during this month relative to the last month, by an estimated 82%, while there was a clear increase in exports for the rest of the other countries in relation to exports of the same month last year, estimated about 92%.

### Third: Kuwait origin exports to Gulf Countries.

As for exports to the countries of the Gulf Cooperation Council, Qatar occupied the forefront of the exporting Gulf countries, as the value of their exports amounted to about 2 million Kuwaiti Dinars, with an estimation rate of about 42% of the total exports, and United Arab Emirates ranked second with exports estimated at about 2 million KD by an estimation of 27% of the total exports. Saudi Arabia ranked third, as its total exports amounted to about 1 million Kuwaiti Dinars with an estimation of 22% of the total exports to the Gulf countries. As for the rest of the exports during this month, they were distributed to each of Bahrain and the Sultanate of Oman.

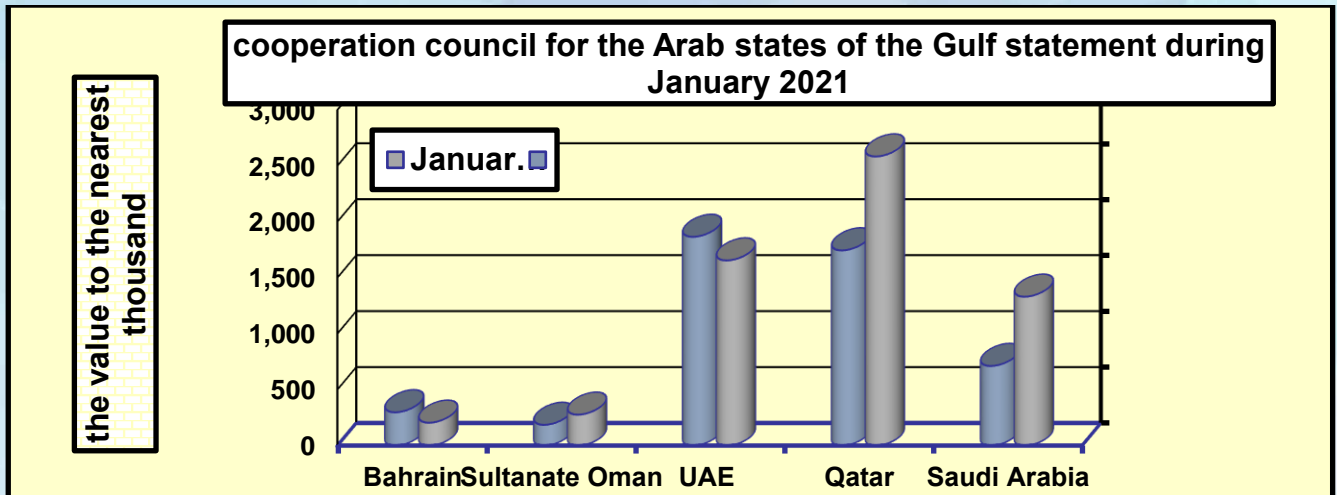
It is noticeable that the exports of the Gulf Cooperation Council countries increased during this month compared to the previous month, by 21%, while there was an increase in the month's exports to the Gulf Cooperation Council countries in relation to the same exports of month in last year with an estimation of 26%

# -Precious metals

The ministry stamped about 2 tons of gold during January 2021, compared to about 1.7 tons in January 2020.

There was a decrease in the quantities of silver that were stamped during this month compared to January 2020, as it reached about 45 kg during this month, after recording about 211 kg during January of last year.

There has been an increase also in the quantities of valuable stones that were examined and evaluated by the ministry, which was estimated about 1108% compared to last January, as the quantities of stones reached 290 pieces during the current month, compared to 24 pieces during last January.

The quantity of gold and silver bars reached 1,082 tons during this month, compared to 133 kg in January 2020, an increase of 713%.

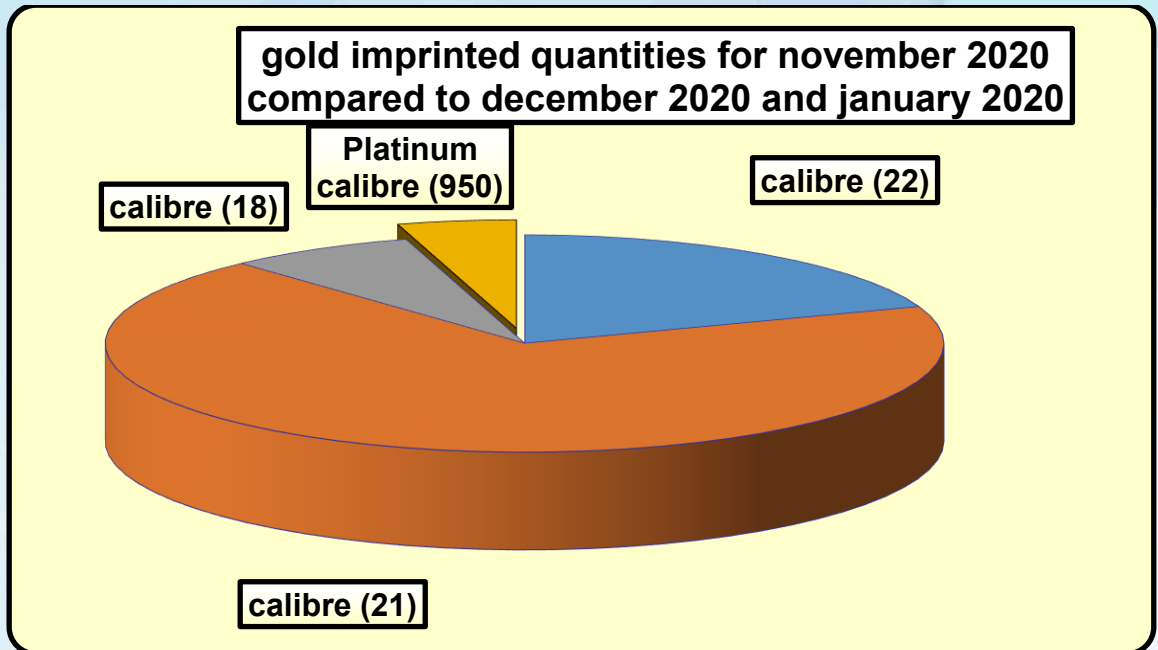

## Giving Support.

- The Ministry provided within November 2020 support for many of materials, in amount of about 12 million Kuwaiti Dinar (12,354.261 KD), so its support has been decreased in rate about 7% from last month.
- The basic materials set which are provided with the rationing cards for this month got about 7.9 million KD, in percentage of 64% of the aforementioned support, this set contains Beshawer rice, sugar, ordinary powdered milk, vegetable oil, tomato paste, chicken, lentils and flour.
- It is noticeable that; its support has been increase in percentage of 27% in comparing of last December, but if we add to this set the support of the infant's milk and feeders with percentage of 4% of the total support, so the gross total support for Flour Mills Company is about 64% of the total support provided within January 2021.
- Also, the previous support amount has been given to the Kuwaiti companies for ration, which total amount was about 9 million KD, its support has been increasing with percentage of 28% from what was given within last month.
- The cement support amount for Kuwait Flour Mills and Bakeries Company and Kuwait Cement Company reached about

384 thousand KD, with percentage of about 3% of the total support, it is noticeable that; its support has been decreased with percentage of about 17% from last month.

- The iron support amount which was provided by the Ministry within the month was about 1.5 million KD, which represents about 10% of the month support, it is noticeable that; an decreasing with percentage of about 17% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- The support of the isolating white bricks within this month reached about 281 thousand KD, with percentage of 2% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 11% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- • The conditioning support reached about 877 thousand KD, with percentage of 6% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 53% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- • Concrete support reached about 1 million KD, with percentage of 8% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; a decrease with percentage of about 5% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- • The cements bricks support reached about 356 thousand KD, with percentage of 2% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 30% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- • Sanitary ware sets support reached about 246 thousand KD, with percentage of 2% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 40% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- • The electrical wires support reached about 298 thousand KD, with percentage of 2% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an decrease with percentage of about 12% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- • Ceramic and porcelain support reached about 15 thousand KD, with a negligible percentage of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 373% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- • The external cladding support reached about 167 thousand KD, with a negligible percentage of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an decrease with percentage of about 30% was happened in comparing of the last month.
- It was provided about 353 thousand cement sacks for 203 beneficiaries, 7.8 thousand tons of iron to 177 beneficiaries, it was provided limestone bricks to 1 beneficiary. And its quantity reached 1,500 bricks. And the white insulating bricks were disbursed to 177 beneficiaries. And its quantity reached about 16 thousand square meters. The cement bricks were disbursed to 175 beneficiaries, and its quantity reached about 2 million bricks.



The ready-mixed concrete was disbursed to 176 beneficiaries, and its quantity amounted to about 70 thousand cubic meters, and these materials were during the month of January 2021. Or the number of beneficiaries of air conditioning, it reached 144 beneficiaries, and an amount of 720 dinars was disbursed, and the number of health kits benefited from 148 beneficiaries, and an amount estimated at 45,000 dinars was disbursed to them, and the number of ceramic and porcelain beneficiaries reached 5 beneficiaries. About 9 thousand dinars were disbursed, and as for electrical wires, the number of beneficiaries was 53, and 79 thousand dinars were paid to them. As for the beneficiaries of the rough dyes, their number reached 40, and 57 thousand dinars were disbursed to them during January 2021.

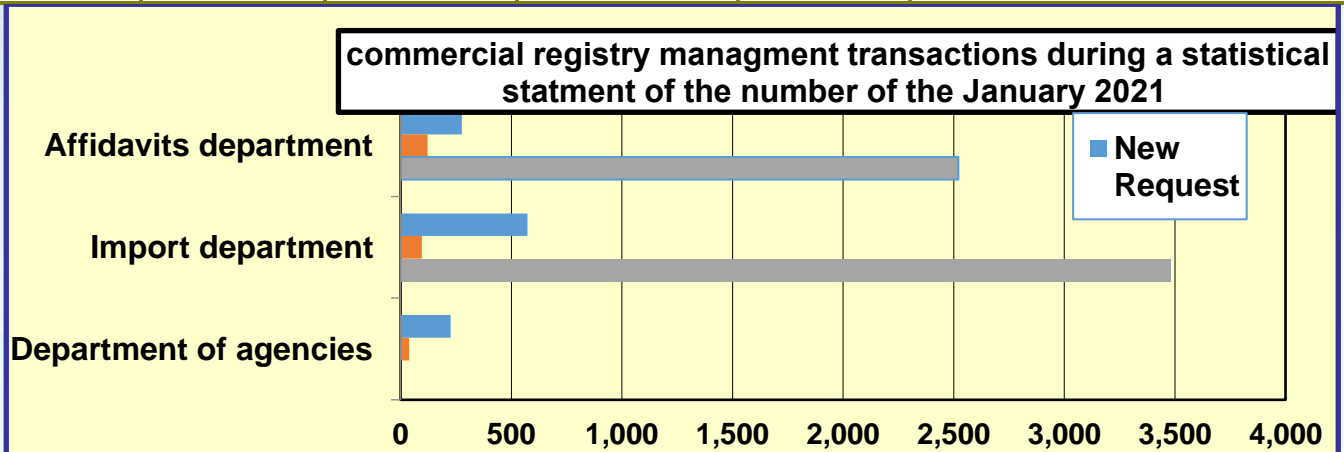
## (Commercial Registry – Trademarks)

### First: the commercial registry:

The number of commercial registry department requests (affidavits, imports, agencies) reached 7,333 applications distributed into 3 departments, the import department ranked first and got 57%, the affidavits section came in second with 40% and finally the agencies section with a rate equivalent to 4%

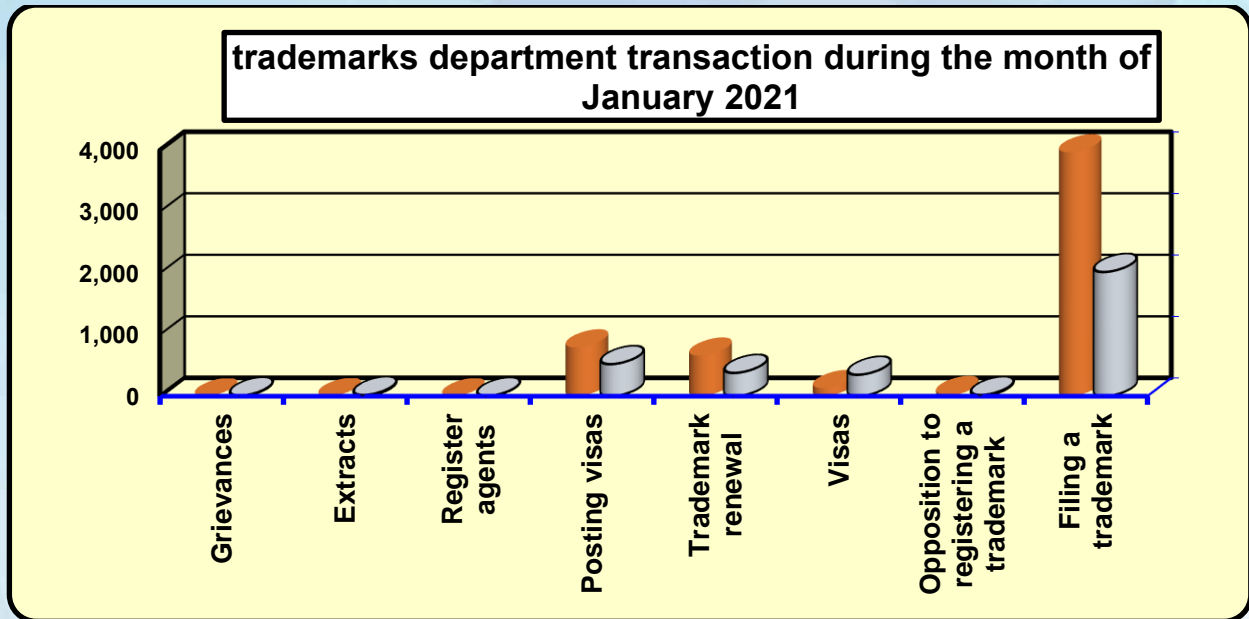
